The Fire District proposes an Annual Budget of \$312,500.00 for 2015 compared to 818,500.00 for 2014. The significant reduction is in the Capital Improvement portion of the Budget due to the funding of a Purchase of Fire Apparatus in 2014.

Complete a brief statement on the impact the proposed Annual Budget will have on the Amount to be Raised by Taxation to support the district budget and on the Restricted and Unrestricted Fund Balance(s). The District's Amount to be Raised by Taxation will increase from \$275,000 in 2014 to \$284,815 in 2015 and its use of Unrestricted Fund Balance will be \$27,685 compared to the \$543,500 used in 2014. The reduction is due to the funding of the above named Capital Improvement. The projected tax rate will increase from 4 point 2 cents per \$100 of assessed valuation to 4 point 3 cents per \$100 of assessed valuation.

3. Include a statement explaining how the Fire District is complying with the Property Tax Levy Cap. The statement must explain reasons for exceeding the Levy Cap and identify the appropriations that caused the Fire District to exceed the Levy Cap, and how they are being addressed by a referendum.

The District is at the 2% maximum cap levy restriction.
