The Fire District proposes an Annual Budget of \$322,000.00 for 2017 compared to 310,000.00 for 2016. The significant changes in this year's Budget are for Insurance and Promotion.

Explain increases or decreases in the tax rate and utilization of fund balances. The District's Amount to be Raised by Taxation will increase from \$285,500 in 2016 to \$322,000 in 2017 and its use of Unrestricted Fund Balance will be \$2,329.00 compared to the \$24,500 used in 2016. The use of Unrestricted Fund Balance was previously used to help offset the Tax rate which is going up due to the loss of ratables. The projected tax rate will increase from 4 point 4 cents per \$100 of assessed valuation to 4 point 9 cents per \$100 of assessed valuation.
