The Fire District proposes an Annual Budget of \$437,910.00 for 2018 compared to 322,000.00 for 2017. The significant changes in this year's Budget is for Building Improvements in the Capital Appropriations section.

The use of Unrestricted Fund Balance is being used to pay for needed building repairs. The projected tax rate will remain unchanged at 5 point 0 cents per \$100 of assessed valuation.
